Fishery Conditions and Rules:

- 1: To ensure we play our part in conservation of the river we have a 100% catch & release policy on all species (Salmon, Sea Trout & Brown Trout).
- 2: Please note that the river is fly fishing only and a maximum rod size of 13ft 8wt is acceptable.
- 3: Please note that there is no fishing on a Sunday.
- 3: Beats and rotations are allocated on the day by the Ghillie.
- 4: Full day fishing commences at 9am for kit out and concludes at 5pm, unless otherwise agreed with the Ghillie. Half day fishing is 4 hours from either 9am or 1pm (whichever is your agreed start time).
- 5: Evening fishing may be allowed on prior arrangement with the Ghillie.
- 6: Please be respectful to other anglers on the river. If you are sharing a beat, please follow the correct etiquette of taking a step down-stream after each cast.
- 7: If the Ghillie is not present, a full catch return should be made at the end of each fishing session. Nil catch returns are required as this information is important for recording rod effort, which is a requirement from Marine Scotland. Text messages to 074000 90050 is an acceptable form of return.
- 8: If requested to do so you must produce your permit for inspection.
- 9: From the 11th of February through to April 30th and from October 1st until October 15th we have a barbless double hook only policy. Out-with these periods, barbed single & barbed double hooks may be used. No treble hooks are to be used at any time.
- 10: The Skeabost Hotel reserves the right to refuse to sell a permit, limit access to or close part of the fishery if such action would be in the interest of maintaining the fishery.
- 11: If you hire equipment from us, at our discretion we reserve the right to charge for any misuse or damage caused. Cost will be based on the value of the items that have been damaged.
- 12: The use of gaffs and tailers is strictly prohibited.
- 13: Any issues that arise whilst on any part of the fishery should be reported to the Ghillie in the first instance. Please call 074000 90050.

Health & Safety

- 1: Wading can be dangerous, guests do so at their own risk. Please make sure you always follow the instructions of the Ghillie. The use of buoyancy aids whilst wading is recommended.*
- 2: Please be aware of overhead electrical cables in places along the river whilst fishing, as electrical conductivity through rods is potentially lethal.*
- 3: Please be aware of overhanging banks due to erosion, as these can give way without warning.*
- 4: Skye is a remote place and phone signal may be patchy/poor at certain sights along the river.*
- 5: Guests who undertake a guided fishing session (with the Ghillie), may be requested to sign a health & safety disclaimer form prior to the commencement of the activity taking place.*
- 6: A full description of the health and safety conditions is available on request.*

Typical daily schedule:

Our Ghillie will be available from 8:30am at the Ghillies hut to meet you and organise your fishing for the day. Any equipment that you require will be provided before your fishing commences.

Full day fishing starts 9am and finishes at 5pm unless otherwise agreed in advance.

Half day fishing starts at either 9am (am session) or 1pm (pm session) and lasts for 4 hours.

If beat rotation is required on the day, this takes place at 1pm.

Our Ghillie will generally be present until 5:30pm to meet you at the end of your day and receive catch returns, unless he has a guided session with another client. In this instance a catch return can be sent to 074000 90050.
